Brown & Williamson maintains and has expanded this already-existing web site pursuant to the recent Attorneys General settlement to give the public access to documents produced by Brown & Williamson (by itself and/or as successor in interest to the entity formerly known as "The American Tobacco Company" (referred to here as "American")) in various lawsuits and proceedings. More than 1,000,000 documents have already been posted on this web site.

Before reviewing these documents, please note the following:

- The documents produced by Brown & Williamson and American in the various lawsuits and proceedings are a subset of a larger collection of documents. For many reasons, the documents are not necessarily sequential. For example, certain privileged documents, personnel documents, and documents designated as trade secret and other highly competitively sensitive documents are not available for viewing on this web site. Therefore, numbering gaps may appear between some documents.
- The index herein relies upon human review of millions of pages. While efforts were made to insure the index is accurate and complete, discrepancies may occur.
